**Title of Proposed Session:** Review and Update of the World Bank Safeguard Policies: Status Report

**Summary of Proposed Session:** In 2012, the World Bank began a two-year process to review and update its environmental and social safeguard policies. Throughout the review process, the Bank has been seeking the views of a wide range of stakeholders to help shape the next generation of safeguard policies. Currently, the World Bank review team is carefully reviewing the feedback received as they are working on a proposal for a framework. In this session, the safeguards review team will update stakeholders on the process, explain the thinking around the framework, and respond to questions people may have.
